Level 8 CCD Class ~ Information Sheet

Please be prepared for Class by bringing the following each week:

Notebook (Marble Composition or Spiral Bound), Folder, Loose Leaf, Pen & Pencil, High Lighter, Religion Workbook - (If Workbook is lost there is a \$20 replacement fee.)

Student Progress and Evaluation - is based on:

- Mass attendance, Mass reflections, and class attendance
 - Mass Attendance – Regularly attend Mass at St. Camillus or St. Virgilius Church. In order to take attendance at Sunday Mass each student must personally place their “Children’s Offering Envelope” in the Offertory Collection at Mass. **Do not put your name on parent’s envelope.**
 - Mass Reflections – are due each week on Wednesday. Mass Reflection Card for student will be given out each week after Mass is over in back of Church. (One card per student per week, may not be picked up by other siblings, family members or friends, student must be in attendance at Mass to receive card.) Students are to give a Gospel Summary on the front of the card and then answer the questions found in that Sunday’s Bulletin under “For the Ride Home” on the back of the card.
 - Class Attendance - Parent/guardian to call Office if student will be absent from class, an explanation in writing is needed from parent/guardian at the next class student attends.
- Participation and being prepared for class
- Weekly Homework Assignments - To be handed in on due date. We cover one chapter a week. (Schedule is in the Calendar/Handbook) Students are responsible for classwork & homework when they are absent from class. Homework can be found on our parish website www.stcstv.com under the Faith Formation heading.
- Knowledge of content material - Tests/Final (If student is absent for exam, makeup exam will be given at the next class student attends) All students have the opportunity to receive a Passing Grade for a failing Homework/Test Mark if corrections done 3X each, signed by a parent and handed back in.
- Christian Stewardship – Each candidate will be asked to perform TEN (10) hours of Christian Service (Internship) between July 1, 2019 and February 6, 2020 and to write a Reflection on it. Candidates will fulfill these hours in a group project (5 hours) – this includes ALL candidates completing the online TEEN VIRTUS PROGRAM - and individual service (5 hours). ALL Christian Service (Internship) must be PRE-APPROVED by either Father Richard or Sister Maureen.
- Confirmation Proximate Preparation Meetings for student and parents – Thursday, September 26, 2019, 7 pm, Confirmation Retreat 9 am – 3:30 pm, Monday, October 14, 2019, Confirmation Investiture - 11:30 am Mass Sunday, October 27, 2019, Thursday, November 14, 2019, 7 pm, Thursday, February 4, 2020, 7 pm
